Description

Retaining excellent colour, worked in wools and silks, depicting Charity with three children in a bucolic wooded landscape, a small spotted dog at the foot of one child, wild flowers and a butterfly to the foreground, a cottage with red tiled roof and picket fence in the middle ground and steep hills beyond, whilst a pheasant-like bird perches on a branch above the allegorical figure group, framed and glazed
