## Description

Composed of various 'tree of life' motifs from different sources, including birds, flowers and foliage worked in coloured worsted wools, historically collated, pieced together and re-applied to a 19th century plain weave linen ground, edged with a woven wool braid, backed with a linen twill, dimensions of visible crewelwork 104cm high, 32.5cm wide
