Designed kneeling on a tasselled cushion, with serene face, and long hair beneath a crown with circlet and fleurons, his high collared outer gown falling in numerous folds around the cushion, on a bespoke nicheshelf stand, covered in 18th century ox-blood glazed linen, figure only 44.5cm high, 25cm wide, 9.3cm deep
