## Description

Worked in coloured wools on a linen twill ground, designed with a finely dressed couple, she holding a flowering and fruiting vine, he his feathered hat, either side an urn flanked by a lion and unicorn, the urn issuing a stylised floral 'tree of life', interspersed with a parrot, a cat or dog, butterflies and insects, the whole within a floral border, framed and glazed, dimensions include frame
