Description

Worked in coloured glass beads on a silk ground, designed as a grand turreted house, flanked by trees, pasture to the fore, the windows picked out with fragments of mica, smoke trailing above the (now lacking) chimney at the main gable end, applied to a modern silk, in a Victorian maple frame, glazed, dimensions are overall
